scissors

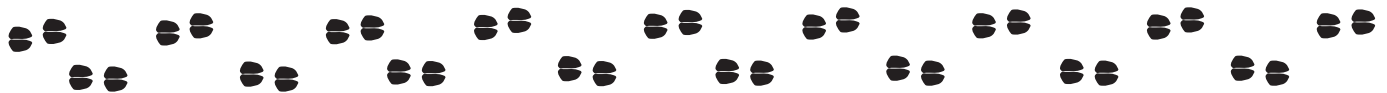
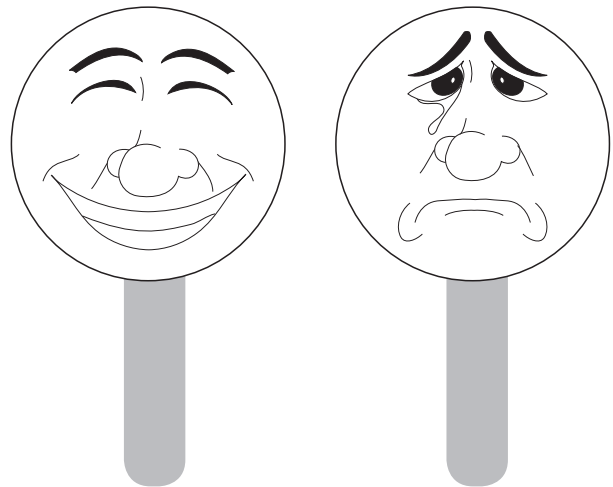
glue or tape

To Build the Puppet

Have children color the happy face yellow and color the sad face blue. Cut out the faces. Tape or glue a craft stick to the back of the sad face. Then tape the back of the happy face to the back of the sad face, the craft stick between them. If you used glue, allow time to dry.

Game Play

When the puppets are assembled, allow your children to hold the sad puppet in front of their faces. Say: **In today's Bible story, Jesus met a woman who was very sad. She had done things that made Jesus sad.** Show the children how to turn the puppets from the sad to the happy face. Say: **The woman told Jesus she was sorry, and that made her feel better. She said that she would do good things instead. That is called repentance. She was happy she had told Jesus she was sorry. Jesus was happy that she loved Him enough to tell Him she was sorry. When we do wrong things, we should say we are sorry.**
