

## DOOR DECORATION



Reproduce this image, one time for each student in your class. Write the student's name in the space provided. Have the students color and decorate their urns. Cut out the urns, and tape them to the classroom door. You could also cut the urns apart and have your students reassemble their artifacts. Keep the pieces in an envelope with their name on it, and give them a potsherd to place each day they attend. Be sure they place the piece with their name on it the first day.



Use the Grid Map to keep track of the relics you find at your Dig Site. Before class, cut out the relics from the Grid Map Pieces page. Put them in a safe place as you will be using one each class period. Display the Grid Map on a wall or a bulletin board. When you have discussed the relic found during your class time, have one of your students place the smaller version of the relic in its place on the Grid Map using reusable adhesive.

If you want to have more fun, you could create a small Dig Site using a pan of sand, string, and tape. When the pan is filled with sand, create a grid similar to the Grid Map by stretching string over the top of the pan and attaching it to the sides of the pan with tape. Before class, carefully bury the relic for that lesson in the section of the grid that corresponds to the grid map. During class, have one of your students use a spoon and a small paint brush to carefully dig and brush sand away from the section of the grid that you indicate until they have uncovered the relic.
